What is this? The 2024 Clambake Society Scholarship is a one-time \$3,000 scholarship to be awarded to a Rhinelander High School senior graduating in the 2023-2024 school year. To be eligible, you must enroll in a nonprofit 2- or 4-year college within 2 years after graduation.

What are we looking for? A Clambake Scholar is someone who displays a keen sense of individuality, cleverness and creativity. They are possibly subversive, probably humorous and definitely dedicated to the principles of lifelong betterment and edification and awesomeness.

Your responses should say a lot about who you are. A personal answer is usually better than an academic one, and it doesn't have to be written. Videos, music, pictures, and non-perishable food items, are all acceptable (and encouraged!), as long as they can be stored in or linked to from a Google Drive folder. We want to see your original ideas, so please don't use AI tools like ChatGPT for writing your essays. But if you've used AI to help with other creative projects, we'll allow it, as long as you let us know which tools you used and how they contributed to your work.

How do I apply? Please hand in your answers to the questions below to the RHS guidance office no later than **March 4, 2024**.

1. Can you show us something original you've created and tell us why you're proud of it?
2. What is the most interesting mistake you've made in your life so far, and what did you learn from it?
3. You have access to a vehicle that can travel anywhere in space and time (like the TARDIS or the Magic School Bus). Where do you go and what do you do?
